Short Film SPANKING LESSONS to Premiere at Cinevegas Film Festival

LAS VEGAS, (May 15, 2007) – SPANKING LESSONS, a six-minute live-action narrative comedy directed by David Schmoeller, will premiere at the 2007 Cinevegas Film Festival in Las Vegas, Nevada. The short film will screen Wednesday, June 13, 2007 at 3:30pm and Friday, June 15, 2007 at 1:30pm as part of the Nevada Filmmaking series. The film premieres at Brenden Theatres located inside the Palms Casino Resort, 4321 West Flamingo Road. A question-and-answer session with the filmmakers will follow the screening.

SPANKING LESSONS contemplates the notion that life begins with a violent birth at which time we got our first spanking for nothing. It's downhill from there. At every stage of our lives, we get some sort of spanking – an embarrassment, a humiliation, a beating, or worse. SPANKING LESSONS is narrated by Teller from the hit Las Vegas stage show, "Penn & Teller: Living in Las Vegas, Live at the Rio."

"It is very exciting to be premiering Spanking Lessons at the Cinevegas Film Festival," said director David Schmoeller. "I think it's important to showcase our local talent in a film festival that is really starting to emerge as one of the leading film festivals in the country."
